



RE-OPENING GUIDELINES

We look forward to welcoming you back to our wonderful club and for some face to face bridge! To protect the health and well-being of our players and to ensure we are following CDC, State and County guidelines, we are instituting some re-opening policies. These are subject to change as the situation warrants. It's a pleasure to have you back and we appreciate your cooperation.

All participants (game directors, assistants and players) must provide proof of vaccination.

Temperature checks will be performed on all participants upon arrival to the club.

Participants must self-certify that they are not experiencing any symptoms associated with Covid or have come into recent contact with anyone with Covid.

Masks will be optional. NOTE! Masks are required to be worn when entering the building by building management. It will also be necessary to wear a mask when leaving the bridge club and using the restroom.

East/West players will pick up a bidding box upon arrival and wipe it with a disinfecting wipe. They must carry this bidding box from table to table. North/South should each pick up a bidding box and clean it prior to use.

Players may bring their own bidding boxes into the club, but they may not leave their boxes there after the game is ended.

Cleaning supplies will be placed in a central location in the club and may be used to clean playing areas during the game.

North will wipe the bridgemate with a disinfecting wipe at the beginning of the game. Only North may touch the bridgemate during the game. After entering the contract and score, North will show E/W and South. North will hit accept on behalf of opponents after all approve.

Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the club as well as at each playing table. Please use this prior to playing and throughout the game.

Boards and cards will be rotated and used only once a week.

Food, coffee, tea will not be served in the club initially. Water will be available.

Players may bring their own food to the club, but there is absolutely no eating at the playing tables.

All players must remove the mugs that are stored in the kitchen. They may no longer be stored in the kitchen. Please remove all drinking containers at the end of each game.

Players may not enter the kitchen to find eating utensils, napkins, etc. or access the refrigerator. If you need something from the kitchen please request it from the game director.
