



RE-OPENING GUIDELINES

Revised 6/9/21

We look forward to welcoming you back to our wonderful club and for some face to face bridge! To protect the health and well-being of our players and to ensure we are following CDC, State and County guidelines, we are instituting some re-opening policies. These are subject to change as the situation warrants. It's a pleasure to have you back and we appreciate your cooperation.

All participants (game directors, assistants and players) must provide proof of vaccination.

Temperature checks will be performed on all participants upon arrival to the club.

Participants must self-certify that they are not experiencing any symptoms associated with Covid or have come into recent contact with anyone with Covid.

Masks will be optional. NOTE! Masks are required to be worn when entering the building by building management. It will also be necessary to wear a mask when leaving the bridge club and using the restroom.

All bidding boxes are disinfected in the evening by the cleaning crew. You may use a bidding box provided by the club or your own box. It will no longer be necessary to take the bidding box with you from table to table, unless you choose to do so.

North will wipe the bridgemate with a disinfecting wipe at the beginning of the game. Effective 6/9/21, players may enter their own number and E/W can approve the scores.

Cleaning supplies will be placed in a central location in the club and may be used to clean playing areas during the game.

Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the club as well as at each playing table. Please use this prior to playing and throughout the game.

Boards and cards will be rotated and used only once a week.

Coffee, tea, water and packaged snacks will be available.

Players may bring their own food to the club, but there is absolutely no eating at the playing tables.

Players may not enter the kitchen to find eating utensils, napkins, etc. or access the refrigerator. If you need something from the kitchen please request it from the game director.
